KEY TAKEAWAY:

Visitor rounds have steadily increased each year from 2020–2022 and are now +30% on pre-covid levels

KEY TAKEAWAY:

Tour Op business had a robust recovery in 2022 from the two previous covid years (which were expectedly low). It was also 77% up on the 2019 pre-covid levels



UK & ROI KEY TAKEAWAY:

Visitor green fee revenue at NI clubs increased in 2022 from 2021 and 2019, largely attributable to bookings from Ireland. Growing from £360k in 2021 to almost £2.6M in 2022 (237% increase on pre covid levels).

Scotland also saw a sizeable jump in bookings to £680k in 2022, which was a 216% jump on pre covid levels.





2022 visitor green fee revenue increased 153% on 2019 as international travel bounced back and clubs reverted full pricing.

In 2022 Northern Ireland experienced a large increase in visitor green fee revenue. Revenue during the traditional 'golf season' April-September surged, but so too did revenue in off season
